4. The Project Fellow should do work full time in the project and get the fellowship from one source only.

6. Decision of the selection committee is final. Canvassing in any form leads to rejection of the candidature.

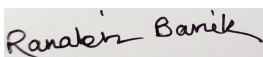

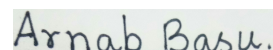
